



## Kung Fu Panda™ Wall Mask

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### ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Time to Complete: Approximately 30 minutes

Level: Easy

### GETTING STARTED

**Materials:**

- Metal-edged ruler
- Butter knife
- Scissors or X-ACTO knife
- Cutting mat (optional)
- Multipurpose glue
- Hole punch

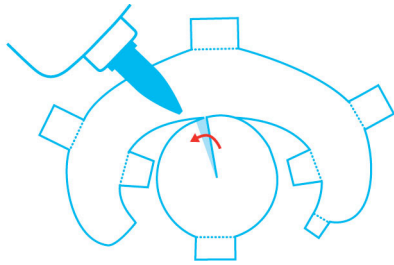
1. Score all the pieces: Using a ruler as a guide, run the back side of a butter knife firmly along all the dotted lines.



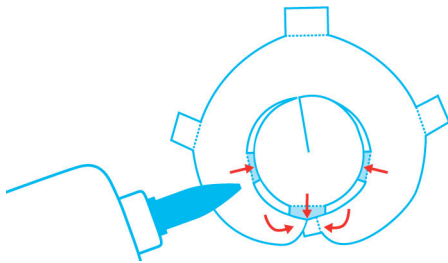
2. Using scissors or an X-ACTO knife and cutting mat, cut along solid lines of all the pieces. Be sure to cut slits in head piece A and the snout.



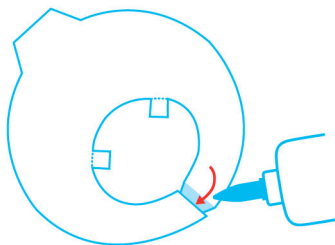
### ASSEMBLE THE WALL MASK








3. Form the front of the snout piece (1) into a cone shape by pulling the right side of the nose across tab A to dotted line and gluing in place.



4. Curl tab B around under the opposite side and glue in place. Tuck in tab C and glue. Glue remaining tabs to inside of the front of the snout.



5. On the face piece (2), curl tab A around under the opposite side and glue in place.

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|    | <p>6. Attach snout to face by inserting snout tabs into the front of the face piece and gluing in place. Next, glue face tabs to the inside of the snout.</p>                                |
|    | <p>7. Fold tuft of hair on head piece A (3) upward on dotted line. Glue tabs on head piece A to each end of head piece B (4) to form a circle.</p>   |
|   | <p>8. Attach face to head by tucking tab at the top of the face under the top of the head and gluing in place. Next, glue each tab on head piece A and B to the inside of the face.</p>      |
|  | <p>9. Insert ear pieces (5) into slits on top of head piece A and glue tabs in place on inside of head.</p>  |
|  | <p>10. Punch a hole where marked with an "x" on wall piece (6). Glue tabs on wall piece to the inside of head as shown, about an inch in from the outside edge of the mask. You're done!</p> |
