ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Time to Complete: Approximately 120 minutes

Level: Medium

GETTING STARTED

Materials:

- Metal-edged ruler
- Butter knife
- Scissors or X-ACTO knife
- Cutting mat (optional)
- Multipurpose glue
- Adobe Reader software

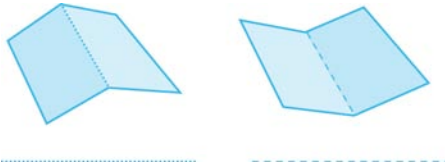
1. Score all the pieces: Using a ruler as a guide, run the back side of a butter knife firmly along all the dotted and dashed lines.



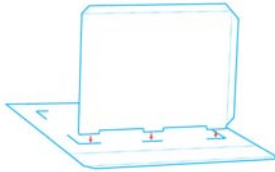
2. Using scissors or an X-ACTO knife and cutting mat, cut along solid lines of all pagoda pieces, including cuts in doors and slits in roof tops. Wait to cut out characters and shrubbery.



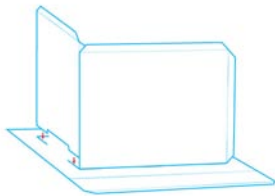
ASSEMBLE THE BUILDING



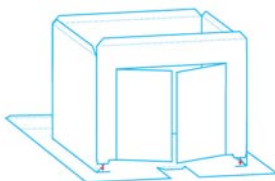
3. Fold dotted lines into mountain and valley folds as indicated by dotted or dashed lines.



4. Insert tabs of building back (1) into base top (2).

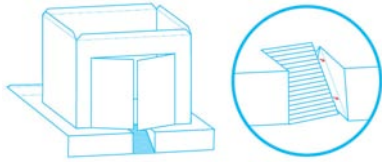


5. Insert tabs of one side panel (3) into base top. Glue side tabs to building back.

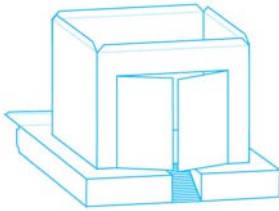


6. Insert tabs of other side panel and building front (4) into base top. Glue all side tabs together to form walls.

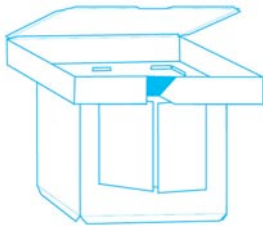
ASSEMBLE THE BASE



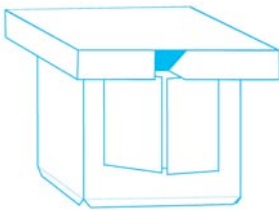
7. Glue white tabs on left riser (5) under left front side of base top. Repeat with tabs on right riser (6) and right side of base top. Also glue the tabs connecting the stairs.



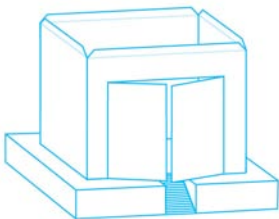
8. Glue white tabs on base left (7) under base top. Repeat with tabs on base right (8) under base top.



9. Flip over. Fold back of base top up and glue white tab on underside of base top to base bottom (9).









10. Glue white tabs on base bottom to inside of base top.



11. Set building aside to dry completely.

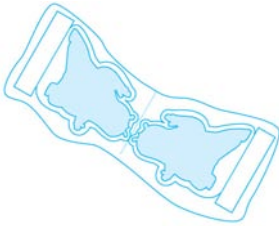
ASSEMBLE THE ROOF

	<p>12. Glue white tabs on front eave (10) to tabs on one side eave (11).</p>
	<p>13. Glue white tabs on other side eave to front eave. Then glue on back eave (12).</p>
	<p>14. Fold tabs down on large roof top (13) and glue tabs in place. Repeat with tabs on small roof top (14).</p>
	<p>15. Dab glue on all tabs and gently fit large roof top into large eaves and allow to dry. Repeat this process with small roof top and small eaves.</p>
	<p>16. Insert tabs on roof side (15) into slits in large roof top. Repeat with other roof side. Glue the tabs on the two sides together where they meet at the corners.</p>
	<p>17. Bend roof side tabs down a bit and dab on glue. Attach small roof and allow to dry.</p>



18. Without gluing, gently place entire roof on top of building structure. Remove to place characters inside as you like.

ASSEMBLE THE CHARACTERS AND TREE



19. Cut around characters and tree leaving a bit of white space.

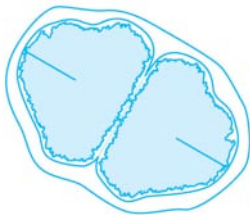


20. Fold in half on dotted line and glue together, leaving white tab at the base unglued.

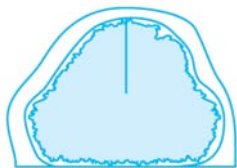


21. Cut out characters and tree on solid lines. Fold base tabs up to create stand.

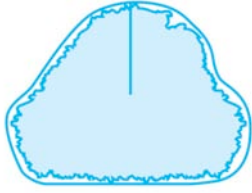
ASSEMBLE THE SHRUBS



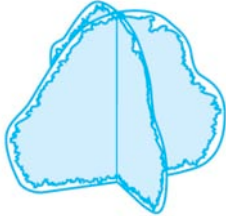
22. Cut around shrubs leaving a bit of white space.



23. Fold in half on dotted lines and glue together.



24. Cut out shrubs on solid lines, including slits.



25. Insert one slit into the other to form a cross.
