From the smallest permit office to the largest federal bureau, two indispensable elements of the modern government agency are people and paperwork. That's why agencies seek tools and technologies that can help them manage these resources—and the agency itself—more efficiently.

Today's government offices often rely on software developed when dot matrix printers were considered state of the art. The inflexible technology requires essential documents to be output on pre-printed stock, often on dedicated printers. What's more, agencies absorb the considerable cost to source and store this pre-printed stock.

The average cost of pre-printed paper stock is nearly three times that of blank paper stock. Likewise, it can cost more than three times as much to manually process forms versus electronic processing. As a result, electronic forms can save constituents more than \$1 per form, resulting in hundreds of thousands of dollars in annual cost savings—with millions of dollars in savings possible for state and federal agencies.\*

Should the agency need to make an unexpected change to a form—a common occurrence in a heightened national security environment—an already inefficient process becomes more pronounced. Staff members must hire a designer to update the form, contact a printer to print the new forms, wait for the forms to be printed and shipped, and then endure the expense and inconvenience of having to destroy the outdated forms.

\*According to CAP Ventures, the cost of one piece of pre-printed 8-1/2 x 11-inch form is 17¢ (U.S.) per page, compared to 6¢ (U.S.) for a blank piece of paper. CAP Ventures also estimates that 15 to 25 percent of pre-printed materials are either thrown away or out-of-date but still used.

PricewaterhouseCoopers estimates that the average processing costs for an electronic form is 36¢ (U.S.) compared with \$1.26 (U.S.) for a paper invoice.
